

All students of VFLA members are encouraged to enter VFLA's annual poster contest. This year our contest theme is "**A different language is a different vision of life**"– Federico Fellini. A cash prize (1<sup>st</sup> place: \$25.00, 2<sup>nd</sup> place: \$20.00 and 3<sup>rd</sup> place: \$15.00) will be awarded in each of three divisions (High School, Middle School, and Elementary). The winning posters will be displayed at the Spring Convention. The winners will be honored at a reception at the Statehouse in Montpelier in late spring, 2016.

All entries should be postmarked no later than November 1, 2015.

CONTEST PARTICIPANTS MUST BE STUDENTS OF A VFLA MEMBER.

Posters must be created and submitted by individual students.

Members of the art community will judge the posters. Their decisions will be final.

The theme "**A different language is a different vision of life**" must appear on the poster.

The posters will be judged on the basis of a) visual impact and overall appeal, b) relevance to the theme, c) neatness, d) originality, e) accuracy, and f) conforming to size requirements: poster cannot exceed the standard 22" x 28" poster board size, or be smaller than ½ the size of a standard poster board.

Each teacher can submit 5% of the total number of students enrolled in all of their classes. Ex: 100 students= 5 posters, 200 students = 10 posters.
